

Mr. D. W. Rannie, who had edited the previous two volumes, found himself unable, from press of other work, to continue his labour of love, and arrangements were made by which individual members of the Committee should select and edit the new volume. Thanks to the long experience, intelligence, and skill of Miss A. F. Parker, who has copied the diaries, calendared the correspondence, and compiled the index, it is hoped that the volume will be read with as much pleasure and interest as the former ones, though the exhaustive notes which Mr. C. E. Doble contributed to the first two volumes cannot now be expected. The...
