The mean degree of heat was nearly uniform throughout April, except for one burst of exceptionally high temperature between the 21st and 26th, during which the weather would have been perfectly dry but for a short hail storm on the 22nd. The maximum temperature for April was 82 (on the 23rd); the minimum (on the 6th) was 36.3. The rainfall was 28 per cent, below the average. In May there were no periods of wide range of temperature.
