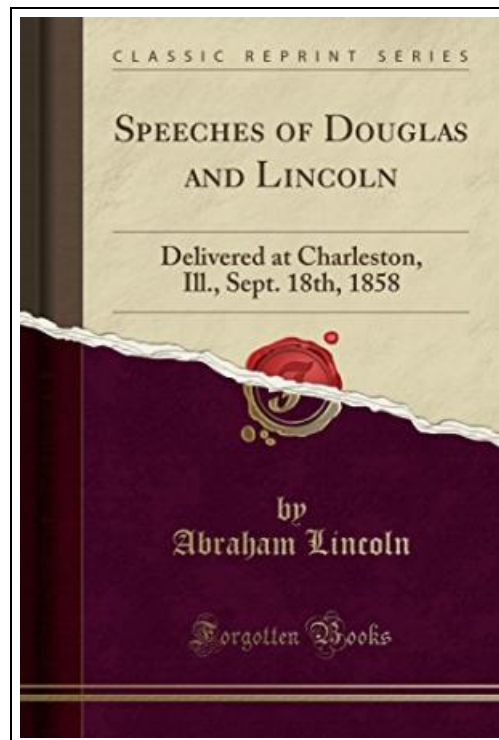

An examination of the record proves that Trumbull's charge - that: the Toombs bill originally contained a clause requiring the constitution to be submitted to the people - is false. The printed copy of the bill, which Mr. Lincoln held up before you; and which he pretends contains such a clause, merely contains a clause requiring a submission of the land grant, and there is no clause in it requiring a submission of the Constitution.
