Of the 481 firms that answered the question about their legal status on the first page of the survey, 436 or 90. 6 percent were the corporate form. The second most popular legal status was the Limited Liability Company, or Subchapter S Corporation, which is a hybrid between a sole proprietorship or limited partnership and a general corporation. About six percent, 29 companies in all, identified themselves as having this structure. Limited Partnerships were about 1. 5 percent, while all other legal structures were each less than 1 percent.
