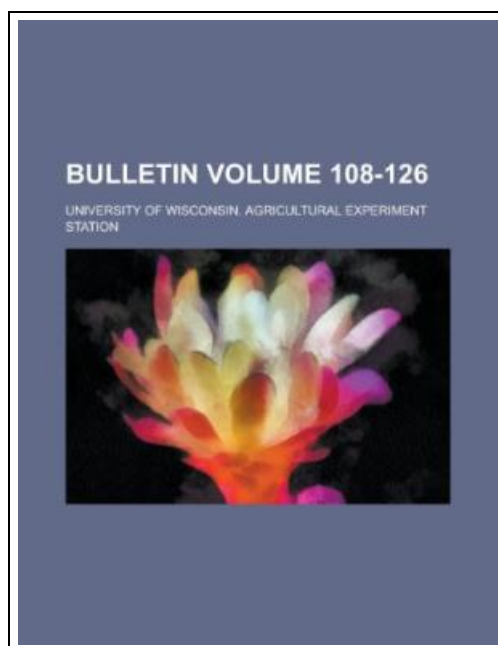

Excerpt: . . . is, generally speaking, safe to assume that a low protein content and a high crude-fiber content give evidence of adulteration. The main materials which are used for adulterating ground corn and oats are oat hulls, oat dust, corn bran, ground corn cobs, hominy feed, etc. , all of which, except the last feed given, are high in crude fiber and low in protein. Of the 50 samples analyzed this year, five samples are considered suspicious from the fact that they contained more than 7 per cent, of crude fiber and one is either adulterated or of very low graae. naving a crude fiber content of more than 9 per cent. The results of analyses of ground corn and oats made this year indicate a marked improvement in the character of the ground corn and oats sold in the state over that obtained in earlier years. While the suspicious and adulterated samples made up 59 per cent, of the total number analyzed in 1902 and 51 per cent, of those analyzed in 1903, only 12 per cent, of the samples collected this year were either suspicious or adulterated. The high grade of ground corn and oats that has been on the market in this state during the present year should be a matter of congratulation to our farmers, especially when we contemplate the change from the conditions that prevailed the two preceding years. While the somewhat lower prices of corn and oats last season may...
