




Driving Vision - The Story of Peter Pan Bus Lines

Peter Picknelly began the bus company, and three generations worked hard from the late 1930s onward to establish themselves in the bus industry, until Peter Pan Lines became the nation's largest privately owned bus company. The text is informative, the photos are of early buses, and passengers, and drivers, the old trolley barn of the Springfield Rail company restored, company headquarters, the Greyhound bus terminal in 1939 built by the family and leased by Greyhound, the first diesel engine for a coach in 1947, driver Willie Smith in 1953 believed to be the first black interstate bus driver in the US, facsimile of a Boston Express Bus ticket from late 1940s, and much...
