

It has 7 percent a year growth rate and substantial foreign investment. Fifteen years after the war of destabilisation, the peace has held. Mozambique is the donors model pupil, carefully following their prescriptions and receiving more than a billion dollars a year in aid. This book is about more than Mozambique. Mozambique is an apparent success story that is used to justify the present post-Washington consensus development model. Here, the case of Mozambique is situated within the broader development debate.
