The fatal shooting of Trayvon Martin by George Zimmerman took place on the night of February 26, 2012, in Sanford, Florida, USA. Martin was a 17-year-old African American high school student. George Zimmerman, a 28-year-old mixed-race Hispanic, was the neighborhood watch coordinator for the gated community where Martin was temporarily staying and where after Zimmerman approached Martin because he appeared to look like a group that had previously broken in homes in the area, a scuffle ensued and Zimmerman fatally shot Martin. Zimmermans trial began on June 10, 2013, in Sanford Florida. On July 13, 2013, a jury acquitted him of second-degree murder and of manslaughter charges, releasing a nation-wide out-cry and protests, for justice for Trayvon Martin, polarizing the races and uncovering the existing racial divide.
