The report was prepared by the Department of the Treasury, based on submissions from U.S. Agency for International Development (USAID) representatives in each country, in accordance with the recommendations of the National Advisory Council. Members of the Washington-based Enterprise for the Americas Board received draft copies of the report and were offered the opportunity to provide comments and/or supplemental views, which are included in the report. Under the EAI, the U.S. has reduced the foreign assistance (USAID) and food assistance (PL-480) debt of Argentina, Bolivia, Chile, Colombia, El Salvador, Jamaica, and Uruguay by \$875 million. Local funds arising from these agreements ranged from \$41.6 million for Colombia to \$3.1 million for Argentina. One of the novel features of the EAI has been the linkage between debt reduction and the generation of local funds for the environment and child survival. Whereas the U.S....
