

H: For Year Ending Feb; 15, 1894 In submitting our annual report, it gives us pleasure to be able to say that in most respects, the schools of the town have been as good during this year as during any like period in recent times. The teachers have been faithful and efficient, and on the whole, taking the year through, the schools have a high average in respect to order, deportment, regularity of attendance, the studies pursued, and the results achieved. At the outset it was decided that a new experiment should be tried; that, if possible, without increasing the expenditures, more weeks of schooling should be made accessible, at least to the more advanced pupils. To that end, during the second term but three of the six schools were to be in session at the same time, so that the older boys and girls might, by taking advantage of the two schools nearest them, have the benefit of two schools instead of one.
