

Nevertheless, the morbid and uncanny aspects of the dead were peculiarly attractive to Tegner and like all Romantic poets he drew upon the imaginative element of folk-lore to enhance the vividness of his poetic conception. This conception of the dead as shades, whose life is a counterpart of our physical existence, was also characteristic of classical mythology, and it is, therefore, not surprising that Tegne, whose artistic sense was so deeply affected by classical ideals, should have occasionally resorted21 to classical figures in depicting death. This conception was no doubt enhanced by the influence of Burger and Ossian, the best examples of which may be seen in the elegy to Elof Tegntr (1815) and to K. L. Beckfriis (1834). The...
