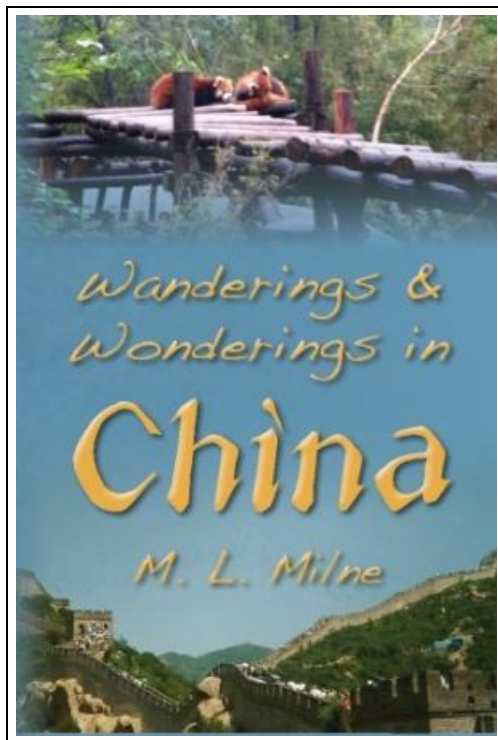

Its an eclectic collection intended to reach a wide cross-section of readers and bring about a better understanding between peoples of the East and West. Light-hearted in places, more serious in others, it was designed to provoke thought and leave readers saying, I didnt know that! It includes photos and has many short entries for those with a short attention span. The author claims to have left part of her heart in China; when you read this book, youll discover why. Comments from readers of the Kindle e-book include: It was a great read: conversational, humorous and relevant. I really appreciated the pronunciation given for unfamiliar Chinese words. It flows easily and I like that its not a story, that I can choose the order I read the passages. This is a surprising book.
